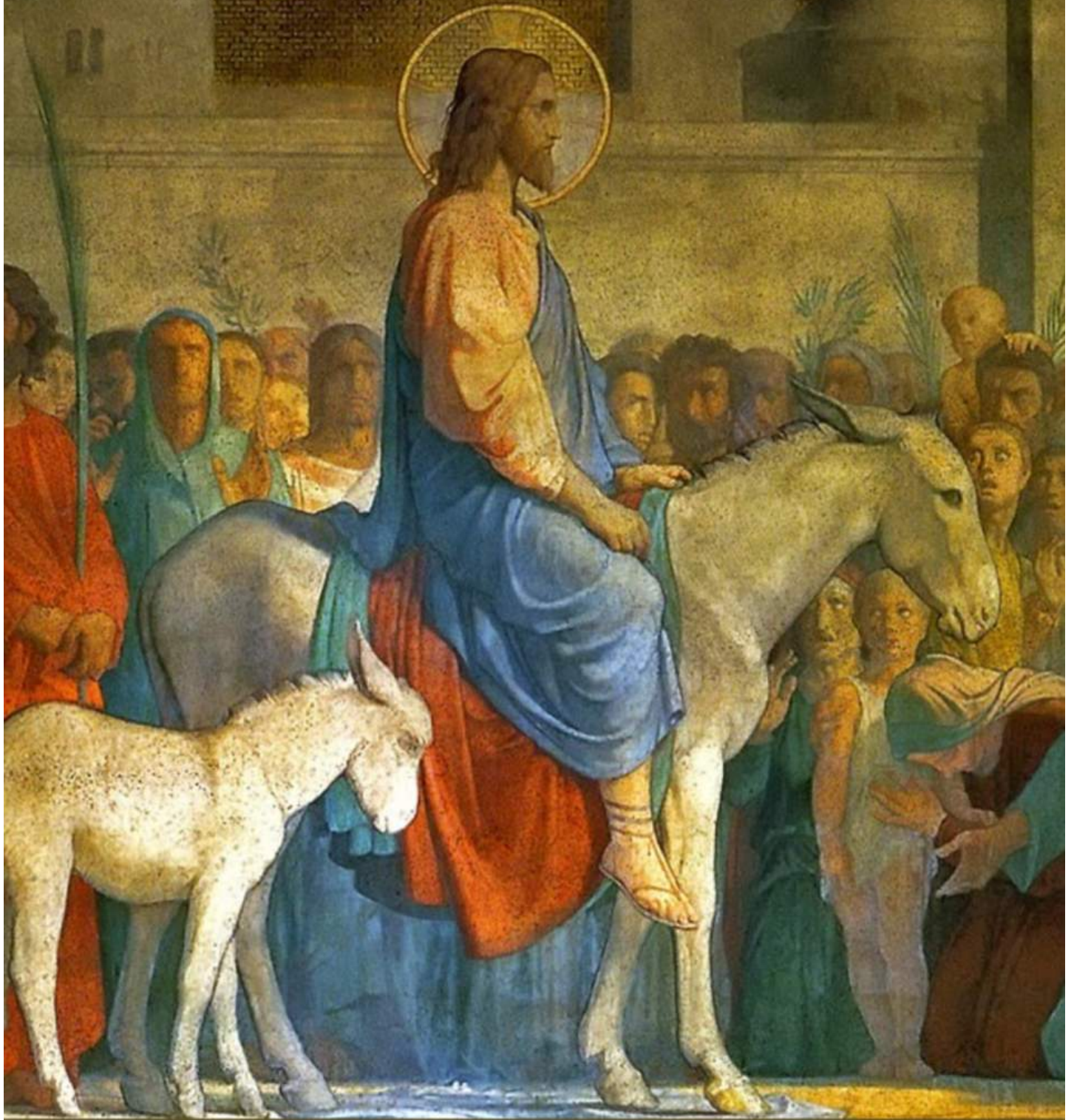

FROM THE PASTOR

### JESUS IS LORD!

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we begin the Holiest of Weeks in the Liturgical Calendar. This week is different than all others and I want to invite you to choose to enter the sacredness of these days by participating in all the Masses and services that will occur this week.

On Monday, all our parishioners are invited to join Bishop David O'Connell and all the priests of the Diocese of Trenton on the for the celebration at the Chrism Mass at that will be held at Saint Robert Bellarmine Co-Cathedral in Freehold, New Jersey at 7:30 pm.

The Sacred Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday at 7:30pm. This Liturgy commemorates Our Lord's institution of the Holy Eucharist and priesthood at the Last Supper. The action of the Church on this night witnesses to the Church's esteem for Christ's Body present in the consecrated Host in the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. At the end of Mass everyone will process with the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose that will be in Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament Shrine.

Good Friday Service will be held at 3:00pm. Good Friday commemorates the Passion and Death of our Lord Jesus Christ on the Cross. No Mass is celebrated on Good Friday; instead, the Church celebrates a special liturgy in which the account of the *Passion according to the Gospel of John* is read, a series of intercessory prayers (prayers for special intentions) are offered, and the faithful venerate the Cross by coming forward and kissing it. The liturgy concludes with the distribution of Holy Communion. Stations of the Cross will be held at 6:30pm.

The Easter Vigil, the most beautiful liturgy in the Roman Catholic Church will begin at 8:00pm on Holy Saturday. It is the dramatic Easter Vigil liturgy that marks the beginning of Easter. It is referred to as the "Mother of all Liturgies." At the Easter Vigil, the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Communion will be ministered to the Elect, brothers and sisters from other Christian denominations will come in to full communion in the Catholic Church and members of our parish will complete the Sacraments of Initiation

Easter Sunday will continue the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord will Masses celebrated in Mary, Mother of God Church at 8am, 10am and 12pm. There also will be 10:00 a.m. Easter Mass celebrated in the Shrine.

As we journey this week towards Easter, please know that you are in my thoughts and my prayers.

## Pope Francis: Palm Sunday

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I greet all of you, people from Rome and pilgrims, especially those who have come from far away. I thank you for your participation and also for your prayers, which you intensified during these past days. Thank you indeed!

I extend a special blessing to the Caravan of Peace that departed from Italy in recent days, bound for Ukraine, [an initiative] promoted by several associations: Pope John XXIII, FOCSIV, Pro Civitate Christiana, Pax Christi and others. Along with basic necessities, they are bringing the closeness of the people of Italy to the battered people of Ukraine, and today, they are offering olive branches, symbols of the peace of Christ. Let us unite ourselves to this gesture with our prayer, which will be more intense during the days of Holy Week.

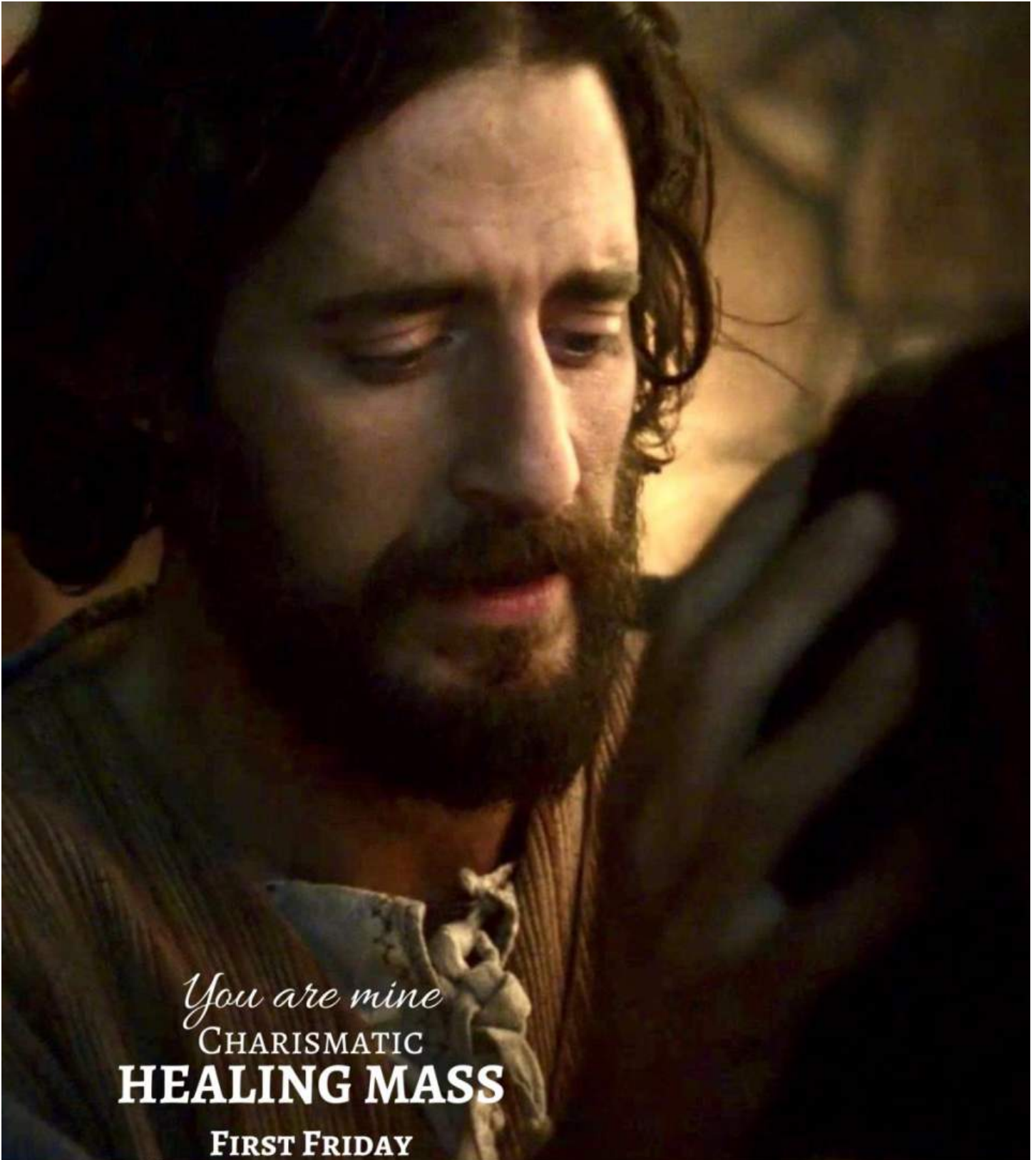
